As UTAC is a proud member of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA), formally Electronics Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC), Code of Conduct, it is firmly committed to achieving the organization's high standards in our operations as well as in our supply chain.

While we continually take actions such as substitution and elimination of materials that pose environmental, health or safety risk, we fully comply with all legislations regarding material restrictions in countries - where our products are sold or where we sourced our raw materials.

In fact, when sourcing and procuring raw materials, UTAC exercises complete due diligence. We require our suppliers to provide us guarantee letter and if necessary critical information attesting that they do not source their metals mined from the Democratic Republic of Congo and/or adjoining countries controlled by unlawful, non-government military factions. We are very much aware that illegal mining being carried-out in this so called "Conflict Region" contributes to human rights abuses and environmental degradation.

Rest assured UTAC will maintain its excellent business ethics and pursue its corporate social responsibility at all times.
