UMY CSR ACTIVITY

On the 30th Jan 2019 UMY collaborated with SWCorp together with the Melaka State Police Dept and held a CSR activity. The district of Jasin was selected for the event to help out 6 poor Chinese families who required items & services for the Chinese New Year celebration. An event was held to clean their houses, repair the utilities and a donation of hampers, stools & furniture including an 'Ang Pow' from the sale of recycled items from their homes.

This event was also attended by Bemban State Assemblyman, Datuk Dr Wong Fort Pin, who expressed his gratitude to UMY staff for their time and effort.



“Gotong-Royong” in UMY



The UMY Community held an activity of “Gotong-Royong” on 12th Dec 2018 as part of a yearly event to clean up the roads outside the UMY compound, mainly in the Parking Area and the Junction to UMY. Both areas have been prone to flooding during heavy rain. Clearing the rubbish, waste and trash which blocked the discharge hole for water to flow into the monsoon drain helped the flow of rain water to prevent flooding. This communal work will be carried out regularly to minimize major flooding in the Free Trade Zone and to not impede UMY employees coming to work and leaving the premises after work.



“Gotong-royong” means working together voluntarily to accomplish a task. On 28 February 2019, the HR Department and the “Surau Committee” jointly organized and conducted “Gotong-royong” to clean, wash and paint the ceilings and walls of both its “Surau” or prayer rooms (male & female). 23 employees volunteered for the program. The activities involved hard work, and the volunteers were happy with their efforts as they observed the prayer rooms turn into cleaner and brighter rooms for all the Muslim employees to conduct their prayers.

“Gotong-royong” is one of many ways to build and cultivate UTAC values among UMY employees. The program enables the volunteers to share and help one another based on friendship thus, forging bonds and strong ties within UMY.
