



Notice: Measures Taken in Response to Coronavirus Outbreak

Dear Esteemed Customers,

The Wuhan coronavirus has been spreading at an unprecedented rate. In view of this epidemic, the UTAC Group is adopting precautionary measures and advise all to refrain from travelling during this period.

The Chinese Government has issued a notice to extend the Chinese New Year holidays till 2 Feb 2020. Responding to this, our China UDG factory has issued a notice that operations will resume only on 3 Feb 2020. We recommend that customers avoid visiting UDG during the month of February until there is clarity on the situation, and instead use the mode of conference calls.

As for our other factories, similar precautions have also been taken following the guidelines set by local governing authorities. All employees who have travelled to China in the recent months are to take a mandatory minimum 14 days leave of absence. They are also required to submit a travel declaration, and all will be provided with surgical masks and thermometers.

Visitors to any of our factories and/or offices will be subjected to a compulsory travel declaration and temperature check.

Please be assured that we will make our utmost effort to minimize any disruptions this might have on our operations and any inconvenience caused to you.
